CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Adv. B P Apte Memorial Mock Trial, Moot Court and Judgment Writing Competition is organized annually at the National level and the competitions are judged by eminent members of the legal fraternity.

Lex Liga, an intra college event is conducted annually, comprising of several legal competitions, such as Moot Court Competitions, Legal Drafting, Parliamentary Debate, Client Counselling, Legal Pictionary, Judgement Writing, English Extempore, Marathi Elocution, Bollywood Moot Court. Annual Prof. Balasaheb Apte Memorial Lecture, is a cherished tradition at the college. It serves as a platform to engage with prominent speakers from the legal fraternity, who can share insights, expertise, and perspectives on important legal issues and developments, thereby enriching the academic discourse within the college community.

Legally speaking, is a fortnightly discussion forum, where the students have discussion on recent judgments or legal topics, to name a few recent ones, 'ADR vs. Union of India: The Supreme Court on the Electoral Bonds Scheme', 'One Nation, One Election', 'Bilkis Yakub Rasool: Supreme Court on the Law of Remission' have been a part of our forum discussion.

The college carries out legal aid activities such as awareness drives and participation in Lok Adalats with the support of the Mumbai District Legal Services Authority.
