Following are the recommendations made by the peer team for Quality Enhancement of the Institution during the first cycle of 2017-2022:

### **Recommendations:**

1. Recruitment of qualified permanent faculty must be undertaken on a priority basis.
2. Mechanism for capacity building for faculty members must be adopted.
3. There should be massive addition of quality books to the library and more professional journals are to be subscribed.
4. Alumni Association must be registered.
5. Post Graduate programme in law must be started and research wing of the institution must be strengthened.
