

By engaging with complex fact situations, teams will learn to balance cooperation with assertiveness, explore creative solutions, and work towards mutually beneficial outcomes.

Through this competition, the Kerala Law Academy Law College seeks to encourage a culture of constructive dialogue, ethical advocacy, and collaborative dispute resolution skills indispensable for modern legal practice. The competition welcomes participants from diverse institutions and invites them to showcase their competence, adaptability, and professionalism.

WHO ALL CAN PARTICIPATE?

The competition is open to all **Law Colleges / Law Schools / Universities Departments of Law and Management Colleges**. The registered contestants must be full time or part time

students of Law/Management Colleges. Students doing post-graduation in law and students undergoing correspondence courses are not eligible to participate in the competition.

More than one team from an institution can participate.

REGISTRATIONS

1. **Provisional registration** – All the interested institutions are requested to provisionally register by sending us an email at – 1stklanegotiationcompetition@gmail.com , the subject of the email should be “Provisional registration –1st KLA Negotiation “**on or before 25th January 2025, Sunday (25.01.2026).**

2. **Direct Registration** – The team intending to participate must register **on or before 3rd February 2026, Tuesday (03.02.2026)** by submitting the duly filled Performa provided: <https://forms.gle/hoTSn31yn2DMTr3g7>

3. **Registration Fees: Rs.1750/- per team** for Preliminary round. Teams **qualified** for Semi Final rounds are to pay an additional **Rs. 3000/- per team** (including food and accommodation).

2. The Participants are required to register as a Team of 2 students viz, a Client and a Counsel.

3. The Organizing Committee will communicate the acceptance of the provisional registration and e-mail the payment gateway link along with all other necessary details for the completion of registration formalities.

4. On successful completion of the payment, The Organizing Committee shall send a confirmation of participation email after verifying the entire process.

TEAM COMPOSITION

Each participating team will consist of **two** eligible students from the same university, **a Client and a Counsel.**

The overall composition cannot be altered any time after registration. The negotiating pair cannot change their roles.

All participants will be assigned a code by the Organising Committee which must be strictly adhered to.

COMPETITION FORMAT

1. The competition shall be held in Hybrid mode.

2. Preliminary Round is scheduled **virtually** on 21st of February 2026.

3. Semi Finals and Finals are scheduled on 7th March 2026 (**On Campus**)

4. If any one or more team member/s back out or fail to attend any round, the entire team will be disqualified.

5. The participants are not allowed to use their real names during the session/round and must ensure that they have a stable internet connection during online rounds. The video must be kept live throughout the session. Participants are required to join the online round 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start time. Failure to comply with this requirement will result in a penalty.

6. The participants must remain seated according to the assigned code and their respective roles.

7. The session will consist of two pairs of Negotiators representing both sides of the Problem engaging in the Negotiation process.

8. Each round will have a set of Problem and Confidential Information for each side.

9. No private caucus is allowed; communication must be audible to all.

ABOUT JAMIA MILLIA ISLAMIA





STAGES OF THE INTERNATIONAL MEDIATION COMPETITION & THEME

The International Mediation Competition shall consist of the following stages:

A. Preliminary Rounds I & II (Commercial & Contractual Disputes)

- shall be conducted online

1. Each Negotiating Pair shall appear once as the Requesting Party and once as the Responding Party, as determined by the Draw of Lots.
2. Each team's Negotiating Pair (Counsel + Client) will be scored as a unit, while the Mediator of each team will be scored independently.
3. Mediation rooms for each session shall be allocated to Mediators based on the Draw of Lots.
4. The Preliminary Rounds are score-based elimination rounds. Out of 52 Negotiating Pairs, only 26 highest-scoring Negotiating Pairs and 26 highest-scoring Mediators will qualify for the Octa-finals.

B. Octa-final Round (Maritime & Transport Law)

- shall be conducted online

1. The Octa-final Round shall be conducted online.
2. The 26 qualifying Negotiating Pairs and 26 Mediators will participate in this round.
3. Role allocation (Requesting or Responding Party) will be determined by the Draw of Lots.
4. This is a score-based round. Only the top 8 Negotiating Pairs and top 8 Mediators shall advance to the Quarter-finals.

C. Quarter-final Round (Insurance Law)

- shall be conducted in physical mode (Vadodara Campus, Gujarat).

1. The Quarter-final shall consist of 8 Negotiating Pairs and 8 Mediators.
2. Roles and mediation room allocation shall be based on the Draw of Lots.
3. This is a knockout round. From each mediation room:
 - a. One Negotiating Pair, and
 - b. One Mediator will qualify for the Semi-final Round.

D. Semi-final Round (Health & Pharmaceutical Sector)

- shall be conducted in physical mode (Vadodara Campus, Gujarat).

1. The Semi-final Round shall consist of 4 Negotiating Pairs and 4 Mediators.
2. Roles and room allocation shall be based on the Draw of Lots.
3. This is a knockout round. One Negotiating Pair and one Mediator from each room will advance to the Final Round.

E. Final Round (Investment Disputes)

1. The Final Round shall consist of 2 Negotiating Pairs and 2 Mediators.
2. Roles and room allocation shall be determined by the Draw of Lots.
3. This is the championship round, and the winners of the Negotiating Pair category and Mediator category will be declared based on their performance.

Mediation promotes voluntary settlement, confidentiality, and the preservation of relationships - values that align deeply with India's traditional systems.

By introducing structured Mock Mediation Competition at the Panchayat level can serve as a powerful awareness initiative. Participants-drawn from local youth, law students, and social workers-could simulate real-life disputes on issues like land, family, or community resources, applying mediation techniques under the guidance of trained mediators.
