



RULES FOR NATIONAL LEGISLATIVE DRAFTING COMPETITION

Bill to be drafted: The Indian Knowledge System Integration in Higher Education Bill, 2026.

PRIZES

- **Winning Team**—Cash Prize of ₹25,000/-, and Certificates with Trophy.
- **Runner Up** – Cash Prize of ₹ 15,000/-, and Certificates with Trophy.
- A certificate of participation will be awarded to each participant.

ELIGIBILITY

Students pursuing the 3-year LL.B. course or the 5-year integrated law course from any recognized law school/college/university within India in the academic year 2025-26 shall be eligible to participate.

TEAM COMPOSITION

A maximum of two members in a team and a maximum of two teams from each institute can participate.

REGISTRATION AND FEES

A scanned copy of a duly filled Registration Form must be sent via e-mail to themisia.snflc.2023@gmail.com and a hard copy of the same must be submitted on the day of the competition at DES's Shri Navalmal Firodia Law College, Gate No. 3, Fergusson College Campus, Fergusson College Road, Pune– 411004.

The last date for registration is 4th February, 2026.

Registration fees of **Rs. 1200/- (Rupees One Thousand inclusive of GST)** is to be paid by every participating team, by NEFT drawn in favour of “**D.E. Society's Navalmal Firodia Law College**”, Payable at Pune and the payment shall reach by **4th February, 2026**.



STANDARD STRUCTURE OF A BILL TO BE FOLLOWED

1. Evaluation is based on structure, logic, addressing legal issues, concise and unambiguous writing style and innovative ideas.
2. The draft shall not exceed 20 pages
3. Participants may attach explanation for the bill not exceeding five pages

FORMAT

Font: Times New Roman

1. Font Size:
 - a. Headings: 14 Bold
 - b. Text: 12 with 1.5 spacing
 - c. Footnotes: 10 with single spacing
2. Pages must have an inch margin on the sides
3. Page numbering should be at the bottom right-hand corner of each page, preceded by footer in italics at the bottom left.
4. PowerPoint Presentation shall be mailed in a PDF format at themisia.snflc.2023@gmail.com on 10 February 2026
5. Three hard copies of draft must be submitted on typed A4 size paper with proper binding on 13 February 2026 at Registration Desk.

VISUAL PRESENTATION RULES:

1. In total, 15 minutes are available to the presenter. Ten minutes to present the bill and five minutes are reserved for Q&A by the panel.
- . 2. Participants must present the analysis using a PowerPoint presentation.

MARKING SCHEME FOR VISUAL PRESENTATION

GENERAL RULES:

1. The language of the competition shall be English only.
2. Once the Bill has been submitted, no revisions, supplements, or additions will be allowed.
3. The identity of the institution shall not be revealed anywhere in the analysis paper. Violation of this provision shall result in disqualification.


4. The ruling(s) of the Competition Committee shall be final & binding upon all participants and are not subject to challenge or review.
5. Total marks will be calculated as the sum of the marks obtained in the written presentation and the marks obtained in the visual presentation.

Dress Code:

All participants must wear suitable formal attire. All participants are required to adhere to the aforementioned dress code while participating in and while being in the audience for any round of the competition.

Food, Accommodation & Travel:

Accommodation shall be provided from the night of 12 February 2026 to the morning of 14 February 2026. Accommodation shall be arranged only for colleges outside Pune. When an acknowledgement mail is sent in response to successful registration by a college outside Pune, a Travel Form shall be attached thereto. Accommodation shall be provided only to those colleges that send their duly filled Travel Forms.



RULES FOR LEGAL QUIZ

CONDUCT OF THE QUIZ:

The competition will be held on the Campus. There will be two rounds, qualifying and final. The number of questions will be revealed on the day of the competition only. The quiz will entirely be based on the theme “**Right to Education and NEP 2020**”

DATES:

Qualifying Round- 13 February,2026 and Final Round- 14 February,2026

PRIZES

- **Winning Team**–Cash Prize of ₹15,000/-, and Certificates with Trophy.
- **Runner Up** – Cash Prize of ₹ 10,000/-, and Certificates with Trophy.
- A certificate of participation will be awarded to each participant.

MISCELLANEOUS

- No team shall indulge in any act of misconduct during the entire duration of the competition, undermining the credibility of judges or that of the competition. Any act to the contrary may lead to immediate disqualification from the competition without the scope of appeal.
- No team shall try to disclose their identity or ask the Judges about their identities; if the team is found violating this rule, strict actions will be taken by the Coordinators of the Competition.
- Any behaviour of indiscipline with the Co-ordinators or any other staff member or student volunteer shall be dealt with strictly and may lead to immediate disqualification from the competition without the scope of appeal.

- No team shall ask for feedback immediately on completion of any round. However, at the end of all the rounds, the participants may talk to the judges with the minimum inconvenience caused to them.

The organizing committee reserves the right to amend, modify, or repeal any of the rules if so required and as they deem appropriate. Participating teams shall receive adequate notice of any/all such amendments or modifications to the rules.

- No team is allowed to use mobile phones during any of the oral rounds for the purposes of research, phone call, texting, or any other purposes.


