The Literature Committee, with an objective to provide a platform to the students to pen their opinions, project their views regarding the presently *hypothetical* as well as the *current* questions in the field of law, ethics, and morality, in their journey to develop a better understanding and deeper appreciation of these developments, hereby declares the themes for articles:

- 1) Digital Evidence and Cyber Forensics – Admissibility Challenges in India Courts.

- 3) Cryptocurrency Regulation in India: Cyber law challenges and legal uncertainty.

- 6) Children's Data Protection in Cyberspace: Are Current laws sufficient?

## General Instructions

- 1) The submission shall be in the form of essays. The same may pertain to a theoretical discussion of the selected topic or a part thereof, or may also involve a discussion of a judicial decision delivered by the Apex Court or the High Courts.
- 2) The content must deliver an 'original idea' or an opinion of the author. Plagiarism is strictly prohibited. Use of any kind of AI is strictly prohibited. Contributing authors are required to ensure that they do not, intentionally or inadvertently infringe any copyright, or any other right attached to any material already published. It shall be presumed that the students, upon having submitted the articles/ contributions in the requisite manner have indemnified the College Authorities and the Committee for, from, and against all and any liabilities emerging therefrom.
- 3) References, if any, must be duly acknowledged, wherever relied upon, as per the aforementioned format. The said footnotes ARE NOT to be mentioned in the footer, but are to be mentioned at the end of main body of the article/ essay. The body of the text of the articles submitted **must** be justified.
- 4) The College and College authorities, including for the relevant limited purposes herein, the Literature Committee and its members, shall not be liable for any plagiarism issues, whether intentional or not.
- 5) The submissions must reflect analysis of either the entire legislative scheme/ general issue, or may even deal with specific legal aspect(s) involved therein.
- 6) Any submission which shall seem to be in the nature of causing any insult, reproach, or offence to any particular religion, race, creed, caste, or a section, howsoever definable, shall be rejected summarily. The same shall also apply to any writing bearing political colour of any nature.
- 7) Any sort of use of vulgar or offensive language shall lead to disqualification of the submission. Care should also be taken to ensure that proper rules of grammar and punctuation are followed. Use the British English system of spelling.
- 8) A student may submit more than one article. In this case attach both the articles in the same e-mail.
- 9) Co-authorship is permitted up to 1 author, i.e. 1+ 1.
- 10) The selection of the articles shall be after a vetting and review of the submissions by the Literature Committee. Final decision reserved with the College authorities. Authorities which shall mean and include the I/C Principal and/ or the Faculty Members.

- 11) The selection of an article may also be contingent on the student/ s incorporating any changes/ modifications/ alterations in their submission as may be directed, within the stipulated time frame therefore.
- 12) A submission which is not pertaining to the format may be summarily rejected. However, the College Authorities, may at their discretion relax the rules for the same, under exceptional circumstances.
- 13) The College Authorities reserve a right to alter, change, or otherwise modify in any manner the rules contained in this notice.
