INSTITUTIONAL LEVEL ROUND (A-CAP SEATS)

Students who have selected this college in the Institutional Level Round (A-CAP Seats) should report to the college on **7th December, 2022** between **10.30 a.m. & 12.30 p.m.**, Admission shall be confirmed on **Inter-Se-Merit** from Reporting Candidates. Being Last Day of the Admission process, on the basis of **Available vacancies**, the admissions shall be allotted to the candidates on **Inter-Se-Merit**.

The students who have selected 'Adv. Balasaheb Apte College of Law' in the Institutional Level Round are **only eligible** to apply for the Vacancy. Admission shall be allotted only if Seats are available in the **Category or conversion of the seats as per CAP brochure**.
