NSS CONCEPT NOTE

Introduction

National Service Scheme (NSS) is a two-year course run by the Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs. It was introduced in 1969 with the primary objective of developing the personality and character of the student youth through voluntary community service. College NSS Unit works under the supervision of University NSS Cell. 'Education through Service' is the purpose of the NSS. The motto of NSS is "NOT ME, BUT YOU". An NSS volunteer places the 'community' before 'self'. NSS attempts to establish meaningful linkages between 'Campus and Community', 'College and Village' and 'Knowledge and Action'. Students completing 120 hrs/year are given 10 marks at the end of each year and a certificate by the Government of India on completion of the second year.

Objectives of NSS:

NSS aims to develop the following qualities and competencies among the volunteers:

- To understand the community in which the NSS volunteers work;
- To identify the needs and problems of the community and involve themselves in problem-solving exercises;
- To develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility;
- To utilize their knowledge in finding practical solutions to individual and community problems;
- To gain skills in mobilizing community participation;
- To acquire leadership qualities and democratic values;
- To develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters;
- To practice national integration and social harmony.
